PENTECOST

28 Then afterward I will pour out my spirit on all flesh; your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, and your young men shall see visions. **29** Even on the male and female slaves, in those days I will pour out my spirit. **30** I will show portents in the heavens and on the earth, blood and fire and columns of smoke. **31** The sun shall be turned to darkness and the moon to blood before the great and terrible day of the Lord comes. **32** Then everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved, for in Mount Zion and Jerusalem there shall be those who escape, as the Lord has said, and among the survivors shall be those whom the Lord calls. (Joel 2:28-32).

This upcoming Sunday is Pentecost Sunday, also known as Whit Sunday, or Whitsun, which occurs on the 49th day (or the 50th if counted inclusively) after Easter Sunday. It holds significant meaning to United Methodists and other Christian denominations too. In Acts 2:1-31, Pentecost commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles while they were in Jerusalem celebrating the Feast of Weeks (Shavuot). Pentecost marks the birth of the Church. It celebrates the empowering of the disciples by the Holy Spirit, enabling them to spread the Gospel and make disciples of all nations. The Holy Spirit's arrival fulfilled Jesus' promise and empowered Christians for their mission.

Remember that Pentecost is a rich and meaningful celebration, emphasizing the role of the Holy Spirit in the life of believers and the global mission of God's Church. In modernity, we do not recognize religious holidays and the Christian calendar like we did in the past yet the importance of the birthday of God's Church is central to who we are and what God has given us. I encourage you to **wear red** on Pentecost Sunday as we gather to celebrate Pentecost (May 19, 2024). The season of annual conferences, class reunions, and summer celebrations is upon us.
